1Timothy 4:9-13

This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance.
 10 For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach,
 because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all
 men, specially of those that believe. 11 These things
 command and teach. 12 Let no man despise thy youth;
 but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in
 conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity. 13 Till I
 come, give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to
 doctrine. 14 Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was
 given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of
 the presbytery. 15 Meditate upon these things; give thyself
 wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all. 16
 Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in
 them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and
 them that hear thee. {1Timothy 5} 1 ¶ Rebuke not an
 elder, but intreat him as a father; and the younger men as
 brethren; 2 The elder women as mothers; the younger as
 sisters, with all purity. 3 ¶ Honour widows that are
 widows indeed. 4 But if any widow have children or
 nephews, let them learn first to shew piety at home, and to
 requite their parents: for that is good and acceptable before
 God. 5 Now she that is a widow indeed, and desolate,
 trusteth in God, and continueth in supplications and
 prayers night and day. 6 But she that liveth in pleasure is
 dead while she liveth. 7 And these things give in charge,
 that they may be blameless. 8 But if any provide not for his
 own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath
 denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel. 9 Let not a
 widow be taken into the number under threescore years
 old, having been the wife of one man, 10 Well reported of
 for good works; if she have brought up children, if she have
 lodged strangers, if she have washed the saints' feet, if she
 have relieved the afflicted, if she have diligently followed
 every good work. 11 But the younger widows refuse: for
 when they have begun to wax wanton against Christ, they
 will marry; 12 Having damnation, because they have cast
 off their first faith. 13 And withal they learn to be idle,
 wandering about from house to house; and not only idle,
 but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which
 they ought not. {end}
